

Earn Tax-Free Money to Pay Band & Guard Costs for Your Oak Grove Student

Has your student joined the Oak Grove High School band or guard? You can start earning tax-free money now to pay your student costs for Oak Grove Band & Guard.

The Oak Grove Band Boosters (OGBB) work as a non-profit organization in concession stands at Sharks games and at Shoreline concerts. For each event that you work, you earn money for your student's account. This account helps offset the costs of uniforms, transportation, hotels, and food. Work just 7 Sharks games to pay for band field season (about 10 games for guard).

Start now to earn money to pay for the Europe trip that the Oak Grove Marching Band & Colorguard takes every four years. A few years ago, we went to Rome and London, and our next trip (TBD) will be in 2017-18!

To take part in this tax-free work program, you must be trained and you must be at least 18 years old. Each venue has different training requirements and pays a different amount when you work:

SHARKS Requirements:

- ORIENTATION Training – Each Year
- ServSafe Food Handlers Class – Every Three Years
- TEAM Training (Cashier) – Every Three Years (Not mandatory, but most positions are cashiers.)

Where Your SHARKS Money Goes:

- \$72 per game into your Oak Grove student account.
- \$18 per game into the OGBB General Fund.

NOTES:

- SHORELINE TEAM training is accepted at SHARKS.
- Money earned for Oak Grove is non-transferable.
- Students who do not attend Oak Grove forfeit earnings.

SHORELINE Requirements:

- ServSafe Food Handlers Class – Every Three Years
- TEAM Training (Cashier) – Every Three Years

Where Your SHORELINE Money Goes:

- Earn Minimum of \$60 or 8% of booth sales whichever is higher per concert, depending on the booth.
- 80% of your portion of booth sales per concert into your Oak Grove student account.
- 20% per Concert into OGBB General Fund.

NOTE:

- SHARKS TEAM training is accepted at SHORELINE.
- Money earned for Oak Grove is non-transferable.
- Students who do not attend Oak Grove forfeit earnings.

Oak Grove Band Costs for Field Season:

Approximate Cost for a Band Member

\$500 Includes: Band Camp, 6 pairs of new white gloves, Meals at field shows, championships, & banquet
Transportation to 5 shows & championships
Lodging expense at championships

\$550 Typical Field Season Costs for a new Band Member due to needing one pair of marching shoes, and a band polo

(Guard costumes cost more.)

Work just 8 Sharks games to pay for band field season.

Working at Shoreline decreases number of games needed.

Oak Grove Europe Trip 2017-2018

\$3,500 – approximate cost of Europe trip

Work 48 Sharks games to pay off the trip.

Work at Shoreline to reduce the number of games needed.

Number of concerts needed depends on commission earned.
